YMCA OF GREATER SEATTLE CAPITAL PROJECTS

Currently, capital funding is under consideration for the Washington State 2017-2019 budget for a renovation and expansion of the Auburn Valley YMCA, a new East Hill YMCA in the city of Kent, and a new University YMCA in Seattle's University District.

The three projects have been recommended by the Department of Commerce Youth Recreation Facilities Program Advisory Board, totaling \$3,046,500 and were included in the Governor's capital budget proposal. Additionally, both the Kent & University YMCA projects have been recommended by the Department of Commerce Building Community Fund Program Advisory Board, for a total of \$4,500,000, but unfortunately, they were not included in the Governor's capital budget proposal.
